Notes:

(1) Under Standing Order 38 (3) the Mayor and the Chair of the Finance and General Purposes Committee are ex-officio voting members of every Standing Committee and the Best Value Sub-Committee. They are also ex-officio non-voting members of all other Sub-Committees and Working Parties appointed by the Council.

(2) Standing Order 45 states that: *"A member who has proposed a motion which has been referred to any committee of which he/she is not a member, may explain his/her motion to the committee but shall not vote. Any Council member shall, unless the Council otherwise orders, be entitled to be present as a spectator at the meetings of any committee or sub-committee of which he/she is not a member, but not entitled to speak unless invited to do so by the Chair. However any Councillor may speak at Committee meetings on any matters related specifically to his/her Ward."*
