

Abingdon Traffic Advisory Committee – 17th June – Action List

Actions continued from 13th November 2019 - Action List

- T15 – Public Participation
 - Town Council to report the faded white give way lines on the cycle track behind Waitrose on fix my street.
Lee Turner - Picked up as part of the Covid-19 recovery plan.
 - **Chris Hulme** - To include the issue of cyclists not using lights in the autumn police newsletter to schools and the community.
 - **Cllr Andrew Coveney** – Faded lines indicating the disabled parking spaces in Queen Street. Add to Fix my Street.
- T16 Matters Arising Action List
 - T6-T22/3 Parking in the town
 - Loyd Close / Boulter Drive: **Cllr Emily Smith** – Time restrictions are due to be implemented in July.
Will car park enlargement be included in the 106 agreement funding?
Can the doctor's surgery staff park further away from the surgery?
 - Town Centre parking bays: **Paul Townsend** to gain a consensus from the local businesses on the time limit for the loading bays, 15 or 20 minutes.
The Traffic Advisory meeting decided that 15 minutes was an appropriate time and no response from the Chamber of Commerce at the next meeting the meeting would make the decision.
Funding for the change has to be sourced. It was noted that Abingdon Chamber of Commerce would contribute to the costs.
 - Nuffield Way parking problems: **Abingdon Chamber of Commerce** to perform informal consultation of the businesses. Cllr Neil Fawcett to be included.
Cllr Andrew Coveney to chase.
 - Other parking areas: Oxford Road (service road) from 4-42, Radley Road between Norman Avenue and Swinburne Road, Junction of South and West Avenue, Wilsham Road. All require informal consultation and someone to promote and pay for the work.
Abingdon Chamber of Commerce to hold informal discussions.
 - T6 - T16 - Road Patching: From March meeting. **Cllr Alison Rooke** to update the meeting with the response from the new Cabinet member including a list of

roads to be patched and if Oxford Road is to be resurfaced due to the number of patch repairs and its continued poor state.

- T8.1 - Roundabout sponsorship:

- **Cllr Andrew Coveney** to chase up this issue with Cllr Neil Fawcett.

Obtain a copy of the joint document between Oxfordshire County Council and the Vale of White Horse District Council which regulated the size of sign allowed on roundabouts.

- Fairacres – Traffic issues in Nuffield Way and leaving Fairacres: The **Town Clerk** to forward Lee Turner’s document summarising the emails received from the public outlining the current position to Members.

Lee Turner to arrange for ‘No Access’ to be painted on the road at the entrance to Thames Street. Due to vehicles still trying to use the road as through road even though road signs had been replaced.

- Illegal parking in front of Abbey Yard, Old Station Yard

- St Helen's Wharf Update
