2	Dunmore Way? Long Furlong Way?	https://goo.gl/maps/s7KTYBc9CSDtKJ116	https://goo.gl/maps/BKEzo8xoEUeM5rab6	From the pedestrian lights near the top/north of the Oxford Road through Dunmore ward, past Long Furlong and finishing on Dunmore Road, just south of the entrance to Tilsley Park.
3	Sustrans 5	https://goo.gl/maps/rm17Au5NQmaCG4ne9	https://goo.gl/maps/9rkaaeyu12e2f3f99	This is a long distance cycle route and marked on OS maps. The Start and End locations are where the route enters and leaves Abingdon. From Drayton at the start and into Radley at the end.
4	Ock Valley Walk	https://goo.gl/maps/MC6eG8D5MAqP9LXr6	https://goo.gl/maps/HVcEsADoyjWWNrw96	Town Council and District Council land. Starts near the St Helens Church office and finishes on the Drayton Road. One could define it as starting on West St Helens Street?
5	Wildmoor Way?	https://goo.gl/maps/fSQ3jTigejKvpVrh7	https://goo.gl/maps/1ZkjuuVZNGnxaTje8	One of the shorter routes starting near the north of the Wootton road and running across to Copenhagen Drive. It continues across that road, over the A34 and hence to Shippon, past the allotments.

Whilst it ultimately cuts through to the Oxford Road at the western end, I would suggest that it 'officially' starts and is signposted at Appleford Drive. The end position is the Radley Road, but it could be defined to end at Hedgemoor, though the RoW does end at the Radley Road.
