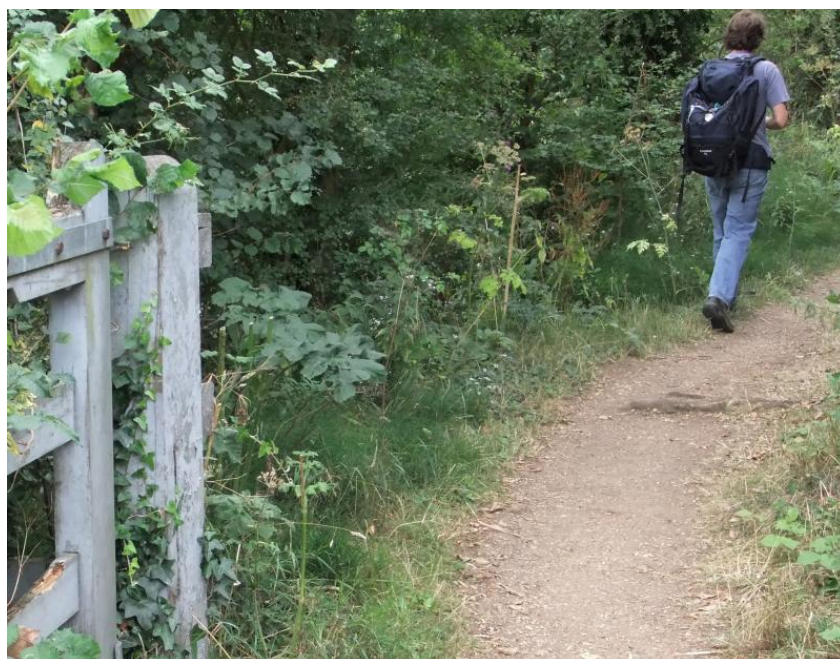


## Walk leaflet under review



**Walk leaflet under review:** The first in a series of walks brochures has now been drafted by the Partnership Manager, with illustrations by local artist Stuart Roper. A team of advisors with extensive local knowledge are now busy checking the draft and advising where changes are needed. Of all the planned walks in the series, this is the longest, taking around four hours not including breaks. It takes the walker through Abingdon town centre coming in on the Thames Path and leaving by the Ock Valley Walk. It is because of these two paths that the walk has the unique charm of being able to pass through the heart of the medieval town but avoids the weariness of walking through miles of suburbs. This walk will be marketed through magazines and other media to attract keen walkers to try the area; other walks will include a town heritage walk and a disabled route to the river.
