TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

- LOCATION:** Radley, Kennington Road
REASON: To facilitate carriageway patching works
- DURATION:** Starting on 16 April 2021
The anticipated completion date is 17 April 2021 (date included). This will operate between 20:00 and 06:00 (Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Diversion for traffic south of closure via Whites Lane, Radley Road, Twelve Acre Drive, A4183 Oxford Road, Hinksey Hill, A423 Southern Bypass Road, Abingdon Road, Kennington Road and The Avenue. Or Diversion for traffic north of closure via Kennington Road, The Avenue, Kennington Road, Southern Bypass Slip Road, Southern Bypass Road, Hinksey Hill, Oxford Road, Twelve Acre drive, Radley Road and Whites Lane.
