



**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ABINGDON) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION
OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT No.**) ORDER 20****

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The order further amends the Oxfordshire County Council (Abingdon) (One Way Traffic and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980.

The effect of the order is to extend by 54 meters the existing **No Waiting at Any Time** (double yellow lines) on the east side of Bath Street north of Stratton Way. This will replace the same length of `Limited Waiting for 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday`. It is also planned to introduce a safe cycling lane affecting the east side of Bath Street.

This is a re-consultation of the same matter from December 2018. The County Council will consider objections and representations received in response to this Notice. They may be disseminated widely for these purposes and made available to the public.
