1. Most stops have a number on a rectangular panel below the sign at the top of the post. If there is no number, give the name of a nearby intersecting road (see examples in columns 1 and 2)  
 2. Newer-type bus signs display the direction as well as the route, eg "Town Centre", or "Oxford". For Stratton Way and High Street put "in town centre"  
 3. Pavement is wide enough, or there is room on the verge. A shelter is 3-4m long and about 1m wide
