

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(ABINGDON) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\***

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order is to correct an administrative error within the recently made town-wide Abingdon speed limit order (implemented as part of the countywide 20mph programme) which incorrectly scheduled part of the A4183 Oxford Road as having a 20mph speed limit as opposed to retaining its 30mph speed limit.

**A. The 20mph speed limit** schedule will see the following amendments/additions:

1. A4183 Oxford Road – its junction with Norman Avenue
2. Appleford Drive (north & south junctions) – to its junction with the A4183 Oxford Road
3. Norman Avenue – to its junction with the A4183 Oxford Road
4. North Avenue – to its junction with the A4183 Oxford Road
5. Northcourt Lane – to its junction with the A4183 Oxford Road
6. Northcourt Road – to its junction with the A4183 Oxford Road.

**B. The 30mph speed limit** schedule will see the following amendments/additions:

1. A4183 Oxford Road – from its junction with Norman Avenue, northwards to a point 74 metres north of its junction with Dunmore Road/Twelve Acre Drive roundabout,
2. Mandeville Close – for its entire length
3. Oxford Road Service Road – for its entire length
4. Wheatcroft Close – for its entire length

The currently installed signed limits which reflect the speed limits approved at the Cabinet Members Decision meeting 27th April 2023, and implemented 16th October 2023 - will remain unaffected by this amendment, with no new limits proposed.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Abingdon) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
