Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

- LOCATION:** Kennington, Oxford Road (Between Bagley Wood Road and A34)
- REASON:** To facilitate surfacing and lining Oxford Road and part of Lodge Hill mitigate works
- DURATION:** Starting on 29 November 2024
The anticipated completion date is 30 November 2024 (date included). This will operate between 19:30 and 06:00
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Vehicular access for residents along Oxford Road to be managed on site and maintained at all times. Access to cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained
- SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:** A4183 Oxford Road ↔ Dunmore Road ↔ Wooton Road ↔ White Cross ↔ Fox Lane ↔ Foxcombe Road ↔ A4183 Oxford Road and vice versa
