Abingdon: Centre North area – Proposed Residents Permit Parking	Grove: Airfield Development – Proposed 20mph Speed Limit
Abingdon: Ock Street area – Proposed Residents Permit Parking	Chipping Norton: Market Square – Proposed Bus Lanes
Banbury: Centre South area – Proposed Residents Permit Parking	Gosford: Water Eaton Lane – Proposed Parking Restrictions
Bicester: Charlotte Avenue – Proposed Bus Link, 20mph Speed Limit & Loading Bay	Oxford: Railway Lane – Proposed 20mph Speed Limit & Traffic Calming

- Written submissions should be no longer than one side of an A4 sheet of paper.

Each response to a consultation will have been reviewed and appraised by County Council Officers and will be included in the report that will be presented to the Cabinet Member for Transport Management. However, it may be that you will not have received a reply to your response. Any responses that were unable to be included within the report will have been appraised by Officers and will be presented verbally during the meeting if necessary.
