



ABINGDON: COPENHAGEN DRIVE – PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING & SHARED USE PEDESTRIAN & PEDAL CYCLE PATH

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct the following features on Copenhagen Drive, in Abingdon – which are being put forward to help improve active travel routes & road safety in the area.

1. **New Toucan Crossing** (a signal-controlled crossing for use by both pedestrians and pedal cyclists) – to be located approx. 26 metres* west of the roundabout junction of Wootton Road.

2. **Shared use Footway / Cycleway** – A short section of segregated footway / cycleway south of the proposed Toucan Crossing will be converted to a shared use footway / cycleway.

* All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the feature to the centre of the carriageway at the stated junction.
